The City Council met in its regular scheduled meeting on March 8, 2010 at 7:00 p.m. Mayor Brookshire and the following councilmen were present: Aikens, Hamby, Henline, Hines, Johnson, and Simpson. Buddy Hathcock, and Bobby Johnson, Jr. were also present.

A motion was made by Johnson and seconded by Hamby to approve the minutes of the February 8, 2010 meeting. The following vote was recorded: Aikens, Hamby, Henline, Hines, Johnson, and Simpson voting **AYE**.

The Fire, Police, Codes, Courts, Streets, and Parks and Recreation presented their monthly reports to the Mayor and City Council.

Mayor Brookshire asked if anyone had comments regarding an item/items on the agenda.

A motion was made by Aikens seconded by Henline to approve the Mayors' recommendation to appoint Buddy Smith to fill the vacancy on the codes Enforcement Appeals Board. . The following vote was recorded: Aikens, Hamby, Henline, Hines, Johnson, and Simpson voting **AYE**.

A motion was made by Aikens seconded by Simpson to approve the Mayors' recommendation to appoint Whitney Hamilton and Tori Jenkins to fill the vacancy on the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board. The following vote was recorded: Aikens, Hamby, Henline, Hines, Johnson, and Simpson voting **AYE**.

A motion was made by Hines and seconded by Aikens to adopt an Ordinance to rezone property located at 200 South C Street from M-2 Heavy Industrial District to C-2 Central Business District. The following vote was recorded: Aikens, Hamby, Henline, Hines, Johnson, and Simpson voting **AYE**. **Second and Final Reading O-2010-3-8-1886.**

A motion was made by Aikens seconded by Henline to adopt an ordinance to establish/erect a Three-Way Stop at the intersection of Yosemite and Biscayne Roads in Harrison Woods Subdivision. The following vote was recorded: Aikens, Hamby, Henline, Hines, Johnson, and Simpson voting **AYE**.

A motion was made by Johnson seconded by Simpson "to go out for bids" for the paving projects in the Street Department. The following vote was recorded: Aikens, Hamby, Henline, Hines, Johnson, and Simpson voting **AYE**.

A motion was made by Simpson seconded by Hines not to authorizing an expenditure of funds to be considered as a local contribution in the H.O.M.E. Application. The following vote was recorded: Aikens, Hamby, Henline, Hines, Johnson, and Simpson voting **AYE**.

A motion was made by Hamby seconded by Johnson adopting a resolution supporting the State Bridge Bond Program being considered by the 107th Tennessee General Assembly. The following vote was recorded: Aikens, Hamby, Henline, Hines, Johnson, and Simpson voting **AYE**.
