The City Council of Lenoir City met in a Public Hearing on April 12, 2010 at 6:50 p.m. The Public Hearing was for Ordinances providing for a Plan of Services, annexing, and zoning for approximately 6.3 acres of property located at 464 Robinson Drive, referenced by Loudon County Tax Map 15, Parcel 359.00. Following the Public Hearing, the City Council met in its regular scheduled meeting at 7:00 p.m. Mayor Brookshire and following Councilmen were present: Aikens, Hamby, Henline, Hines, and Simpson. Dale Hurst, Buddy Hathcock, and Bobby Johnson, Jr. were also present. Councilman Johnson was absent.

A motion was made by Henline and seconded by Hamby to approve the minutes of the March 22, 2010 meeting. The following vote was recorded: Aikens, Hamby, Henline, Hines, and Simpson voting **AYE**. Johnson absent.

The Fire, Police, Codes, Courts, Streets, and Parks and Recreation presented their monthly reports to the Mayor and City Council.

Mayor Brookshire asked if anyone had comments regarding an item/items on the agenda.

A motion was made by Simpson seconded by Hines to approve the second and final reading of an Ordinance providing for a Plan of Services for approximately 6.3 acres of property located at 464 Robinson Drive, referenced by Loudon County Tax Map 15, Parcel 359.00. The following vote was recorded: Aikens, Hamby, Henline, Hines, and Simpson voting **AYE**. Johnson absent.

**Second and Final Reading Ordinance 2010-4-12-1890-A.**

A motion was made by Henline seconded by Hamby to approve the second and final reading of an Ordinance annexing and zoning approximately 6.3 acres of property located at 464 Robinson Drive, referenced by Loudon County Tax Map 15, Parcel 359.00. **Second and Final Reading Ordinance 2010-4-12-1890-B.**

A motion was made by Aikens seconded by Simpson to approve the second and final reading of an Ordinance to establish/erect a Three-Way Stop at the intersection of Yosemite and Biscayne Roads in Harrison Woods Subdivision. The following vote was recorded: Aikens, Hamby, Henline, Hines, and Simpson voting **AYE**. Johnson absent.

**Second and Final Reading Ordinance 2010-4-12-1890-C.**

A motion was made by Aikens seconded by Henline to approve the 2008-2009 Budget Amendments for the Special Revenue Funds concerning Downtown VIP, Creekwood Capital Project, DEA Fund, State Street Aid Fund, Home Program, and the Capital Project Fund. The following vote was recorded: Aikens, Hamby, Henline, Hines, and Simpson voting **AYE**. Johnson absent.

A motion was made by Aikens seconded by Simpson to adopt a Resolution to request that the Loudon County Election Commission hold a City Election for the election of officials as required by the Charter of Lenoir City, on Tuesday, November 2, 2010 from 8:00 A.M. until 8:00 P.M. The following vote was recorded: Aikens, Hamby, Henline, Hines, and Simpson voting **AYE**. Johnson absent. **Resolution 2010-4-12-1890.**

Mayor Brookshire asked for comments from citizens regarding item/items not on the agenda.

A motion was made by Hamby and seconded by Aikens to approve all bills and accounts to be paid when properly approved and funds available. The following vote was recorded: Aikens, Hamby, Henline, Hines, and Simpson voting **AYE**. Johnson absent.

A motion was made by Hines and seconded by Henline to adjourn the April 12, 2010 meeting. The following vote was recorded: Aikens, Hamby, Henline, Hines, and Simpson voting **AYE**. Johnson absent
