A motion was made by Hamby and seconded by Simpson to approve the minutes of the December 14, 2009 meeting. The following vote was recorded: Hamby, Henline, Hines, Johnson, and Simpson voting **AYE**. **Aikens absent.**

Mayor Brookshire announced that the City Council Meeting schedule for January 18, 2010 has been cancelled and will be held on Monday, January 25, 2010 at 7:00 P.M.

The Fire, Police, Codes, Courts, Streets, and Parks and Recreation presented their monthly reports to the Mayor and City Council.
