The City Council met in its regularly scheduled meeting at 7:00 P.M. Mayor Brookshire and the following Councilmen were present: Aikens, Hamby, Henline, Hines, Johnson, and Simpson. Dale Hurst, Buddy Hathcock, and Bobby Johnson, Jr. were also present.

A motion was made by Johnson and seconded by Hamby to approve the minutes of the April 26, 2010 meeting. The following vote was recorded: Aikens, Hamby, Henline, Hines, Johnson, and Simpson voting **AYE**.

The Fire, Police, Codes, Court, Street/Sanitation, and Parks and Recreation Departments presented their monthly reports to the Mayor and City Council.

Mayor Brookshire asked if there were any comments from citizens regarding an item/items on the agenda.

A motion was made by Simpson and seconded by Aikens to add an item to the agenda. The following vote was recorded: Aikens, Hamby, Henline, Hines, Johnson, and Simpson voting **AYE**.

A motion was made by Johnson and seconded by Hamby to approve of changing Life, Accidental Death and Dismemberment, and Long Term Disability Insurance carrier to The Hartford, at a savings. This coverage will become effective on July 1, 2010. The following vote was recorded: Aikens, Hamby, Henline, Hines, Johnson, and Simpson voting **AYE**.

A motion was made by Hines and seconded by Johnson to approve the second and final reading of an Ordinance establishing two (2) Handicapped Parking Spaces for the Good Samaritan Center. The following vote was recorded: Aikens, Hamby, Henline, Hines, Johnson, and Simpson voting **AYE**.

**Second and Final Reading. Ordinance 2010-5-10-1894.**

A motion was made by Simpson and seconded by Hines to adopt a Resolution to accept the completed streets within the Harrison Woods and Acadia Villas Residential Developments. The following vote was recorded: Aikens, Hamby, Henline, Hines, and Simpson voting **AYE**. Johnson **ABSTAINS**.

**Resolution 2010-5-10-1894A.**

A motion was made by Hines and seconded by Henline to adopt a Resolution to accept the completed streets within the Market at Town Creek Commercial Development. The following vote was recorded: Aikens, Hamby, Henline, Hines, Johnson, and Simpson voting **AYE**.

**Resolution 2010-5-10-1894B.**

An item was added to the agenda. A motion was made by Henline and seconded by Johnson to retire K-9, Sting, and sell to Handler for \$1.00. The following vote was recorded: Aikens, Hamby, Henline, Hines, Johnson, and Simpson voting **AYE**.

Mayor Brookshire asked for comments from citizens regarding an item/items not on the agenda.

A motion was made by Hamby and seconded by Aikens to approve of all bills and accounts to be paid when properly approved and funds available. The following vote was recorded: Aikens, Hamby, Henline, Hines, Johnson, and Simpson voting **AYE**.

A motion was made by Henline and seconded by Hines to adjourn the May 10, 2010 meeting. The following vote was recorded: Aikens, Hamby, Henline, Hines, and Simpson voting **AYE**. Johnson voting **NO**.
